




Books in WA - The Reality

71% of WA kids read for pleasure - down from 79% just a few years ago.

90% of children spend more time on screens than on books

Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, participation in creative writing among children dropped from 23% to 19%.


Only ~50% of Australians read for enjoyment

WORKSHOP



ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Zines (short for 'magazines' or 'fanzines') are handmade, self-published booklets that give anyone the power to share their voices, ideas, and creativity. In this workshop, participants will design and create their own zines - exploring zine-making as both a fun hands-on activity, and as a form of independent publishing and self-expression.

Perfect for schools, youth groups & services, libraries & community centres, arts & wellbeing programs, and community festivals and events.

FORMAT

Duration: Flexible (45min - 1/2 day program)

Group Size: 10 - 30

Age Group: 10+ **Adjustments can be made for younger groups

Delivery Mode: In-person facilitated workshop / independent activity at bookstore pop-up

MATERIALS/RESOURCES

- ✓ Paper, Pens, Scissors, Glue, Collage Items, Example Zines.

Host to Provide

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Stories Closer To You is a **creative workshop designed to help young people and communities reconnect with reading** - not as a task, but as something meaningful, personal, and enjoyable.

Through conversation, hands-on activities, and story exploration, participants discover how books reflect their lives, their questions, and their world.

Perfect for schools, youth groups, libraries, community spaces, and wellbeing programs.

FORMAT

Duration: Flexible (45min - ½ day)
Group Size: 10 - 30
Age Group: 8+ Adaptable for All Ages
Delivery Mode: In-person facilitated workshop, independent activity at bookstore pop-up

MATERIALS/RESOURCES

Provided by Maesons Soapbox

- Curated books, reading prompts, activity resources, facilitation.

WHAT PARTICIPANTS WILL DO

- Explore stories that reflect their own lives & experiences
- Discover books that match their interests, ideas, & curiosity
- Engage in low-pressure, creative reading activities
- Build confidence and connection around reading
- Leave with new ideas about what reading can be

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Community Story Walls is a participatory storytelling experience where individuals and communities are invited to contribute short stories, reflections, drawings, quotes, and messages that come together to form a shared public artwork.

The wall becomes a living collection of voices - celebrating identity, place, memory, and belonging.

Perfect for schools, libraries, festivals, community events, youth spaces, and public programs.

FORMAT

Duration: Flexible (1-6hr or Multi-day)

Audience: All Ages

Delivery Mode: On-site facilitated installation

WHAT PARTICIPANTS WILL DO

- ✓ Share short written reflections, stories, quotes, and drawings.
- ✓ Respond to creative prompts about identity, place, and community.
- ✓ Contribute to a growing collective artwork.
- ✓ See their voice become part of something larger.

MATERIALS/RESOURCES

- ✓ Story wall materials, prompts, creative tools, facilitation.

Creative Voice and Self-Expression



WORKSHOP

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Youth Expression Workshops are creative sessions that support young people to explore their voice across different forms of expression - including writing, art, spoken word, and creative media.

Developed in collaboration with youth platforms such as WhyNot, these workshops create space for young people to share what matters to them, in the ways that feel most natural and powerful.

The focus is on process over perfection, encouraging creativity, curiosity, and courage across all forms of storytelling.

Perfect for schools, youth programs, libraries, and community spaces.

FORMAT

Duration: Flexible (45min - ½ day)
Group Size: 10 - 30
Age Group: 15 - 30
Delivery Mode: In-person facilitated workshop

WHAT PARTICIPANTS WILL DO

- ✓ Explore different forms of creative expression.
- ✓ Respond to creative prompts and story starters.
- ✓ Create personal pieces across one or multiple mediums.
- ✓ Share (optionally) in a supportive space.
- ✓ Build confidence in their voice and ideas.

PROGRAM

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Collaborative Anthologies is a longer-form storytelling project where participants move from idea to finished publication — contributing writing, artwork, and creative pieces to a shared print or digital anthology.

This program brings together the creative process of workshops with the real-world experience of publishing, offering young people and communities the opportunity to see their stories preserved, celebrated, and shared.

Perfect for schools, youth programs, community groups, libraries, and regional projects.

FORMAT

Duration: Multi-session (Custom Design)

Group Size: 10-30 (flexible by project)

Age Group: 15 - 30 (flexible)

Delivery Mode: In-person workshops with optional online collaboration

OUTCOMES

Increased confidence in creative work and collaboration; Practical experience in publishing; Strengthened community connection through shared storytelling; Tangible published outcome to keep and share.

MATERIALS/RESOURCES

WHAT PARTICIPANTS WILL DO

- Develop original written, visual, and creative works.
- Participate in guided workshops across drafting, editing, and design.
- Learn the basic of publishing and collaboration.

- Celebrate their work through a launch or showcase event.

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Workshop & Facilitation Fees

Session Options:

45-60min session - \$350
Best for taster sessions, classes, festivals & short programs

90 min session - \$500
Allows time for deeper creative work and skill development.

2 hour session - \$700
Full creative arc with extended making, reflection & collaboration

Half-day program (3-4 hrs) - \$950
Includes multiple creative cycles, extended support, and optional showcase/reflection


